Severe Winter Weather

BACKGROUND:

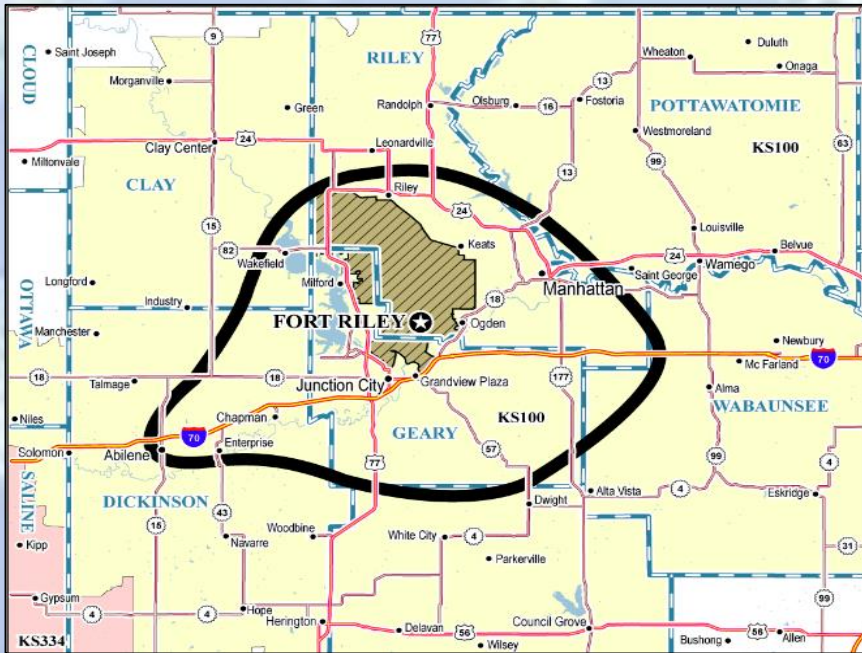
- Kansas Severe Wx season occurs from 1 NOV – 30 APR; severe cold, wind chill temps, 10-12" average annual snowfall, occasional blizzard.
- Soldiers, Families and Civilians from warmer climates are at greatest risk for accidents.
- 12 total Winter Wx events last year, minimal impact to the Installation or Training.
- Winter Wx is a Regional Issue, 50K FRKS commuters daily.
- Road Conditions on post typically better than the surrounding communities.
- Process in place to make PT, Workforce Reporting Decisions and Early Releases.
- USD 475 closely tied in with the Installation decision making
- IACH involved in the Installation decision making process; often remains open to make full use of any available appointment times.
- Fort Riley Police Department classifies Road Conditions:

Green: No safety threat to the public due to weather conditions.

Amber: Difficult to hazardous road conditions. Roads icy or snow packed, clearing operations making roads passable.

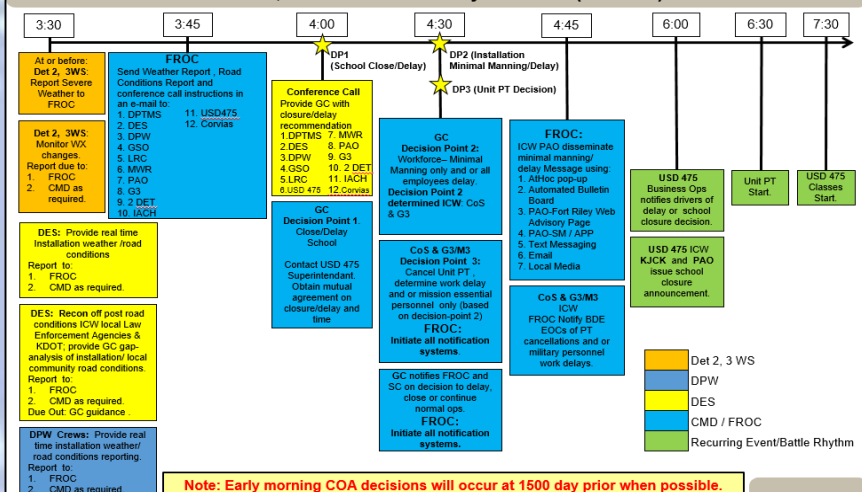
Red: Most intersections present difficult conditions or NO stopping ability.

EFFECTS: Severe winter weather preparedness planning postures the 1ID and Fort Riley to respond and mitigate the effects of severe winter storms to include blizzard, ice, enabling safe commuting, schools and training.

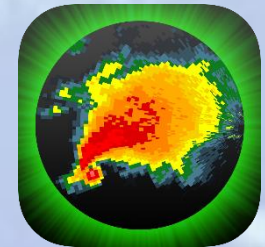

Child & Youth Services

➤ Inclement Weather Plan:

- For minimal manning/limited service, full day child care will be consolidated at Whitside CDC, building 676, for minimal manning patrons (ages 6 weeks-5th grade). Patrons can request a minimal manning form from the front desk of their center.
- For delayed opening, CDCs will open at 0700. If there is a post delayed opening and USD 475 operates a normal schedule, School Age Centers will NOT open for before-school care. After-school care will operate as scheduled. If post and USD 475 both have delayed openings, School Age Centers will open at 0700 for all care.
- For phased releases, programs will contact families to pick up within 1 hour from the announced post release time.
- Notifications of minimal manning, limited service, delayed opening, or phased release will be made using the Remind system and posted on the Riley CYS Facebook page.

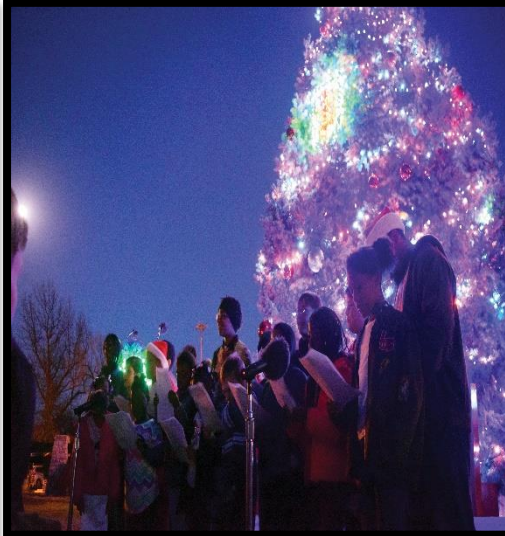

- Active duty service members have a \$0 copay for covered drugs at any pharmacy.

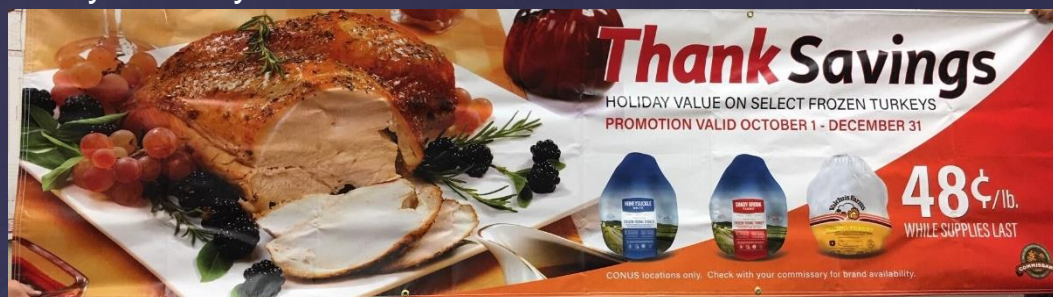

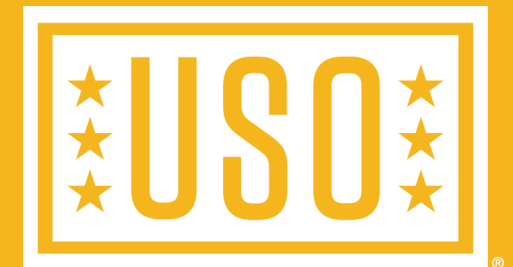

Information to Have Ready

When contacting the Red Cross, be prepared to provide the following information (if you do not have all the information, please use the phone option):

Service member information

- Full legal name
- Rank/rating
- Branch of service (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard)
- Social Security Number or Date of Birth
- Military unit address
- Information about the deployed unit and home base unit (for deployed service members only)

Information about the Emergency

- Name and contact for the immediate family member experiencing the emergency (could be spouse, parent, child/grandchild, or grandparent)
- Nature of the emergency
- Where the emergency can be verified
